Participants develop the ability to handle difficult conversations, manage differing viewpoints, and resolve issues effectively while maintaining positive working relationships and organisational alignment.

WHO THE PROGRAMME IS FOR

This workshop is designed for professionals working within structured, team-based, or leadership environments, including:

- Project and programme managers
- Team leaders and supervisors
- Professionals working within government or corporate environments
- Individuals responsible for managing stakeholders, teams, or complex working relationships
